Arrests for Immediate Release September 2023

A 41 year old Rensselaer resident was arrested by Officer Max Scheibly following a menacing complaint. The defendant menaced the victim with a handgun while inside Walmart. The defendant was charged with Menacing in the Second Degree, and was processed, arraigned and released to reappear in court at a later date.

A 25 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Bernadette Ellis following a criminal mischief complaint. The defendant was charged with Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree and Harassment in the Second Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and released to reappear in court at a later date.

A 29 year Troy resident was arrested by Officer Peter Lavin following a harassment complaint. The defendant made verbal threats to harm. The defendant was field processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

A 56 year old Rensselaer resident was arrested by Officer Keith Millington following a menacing complaint. An investigation revealed the defendant menaced the victim with a baseball bat. The defendant was charged with Menacing in the Second Degree, Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Fourth Degree. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

A 40 year old Schenectady resident was arrested by Sergeant Trevor LaGrave following a traffic stop. The defendant operated a motor vehicle with a suspended New York State driver's license. An investigation revealed the defendant had more than 10 suspensions on 10 or more dates. The defendant was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the First Degree, Speed in Zone and Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Inspection. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

A 27 year old Hudson resident was arrested by Officer Shelby Herrington following a shoplifting complaint at Hannaford. The defendant passed all points of sale without paying for merchandise. The defendant was charged with Petit Larceny, and was processed and released to appear in court at a later date.

A 36 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Bernadette Ellis following a larceny complaint. The defendant did steal property belonging to another. The defendant was charged with Petit Larceny, and was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

The defendant violated a full stay-away order of protection by going to the victim's house. The defendant was charged with Criminal Contempt in the Second Degree, and was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

The defendant was charged with Petit Larceny, and was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.

The defendant subjected the victim to unwanted physical contact by striking her and causing a mark on her arm. The defendant was charged with Harassment in the Second Degree, and was processed and released on an appearance ticket to appear in court at a later date.
