SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Graduating seniors of Columbia High School may apply for the East Greenbush Police Benevolent Association Scholarship in memory of Officer Edward L. Witko.

Edward Witko lived for his family, friends and chosen profession. During his ten year career in law enforcement he served with honesty, integrity and loyalty and was admired by all. He trained with an intensity that gave all who knew him comfort that he was part of our department. He believed in brotherhood and his unquestioning faith and dedication to law enforcement made us all proud to call him "Brother".

On August 15, 2010 Officer Edward L Witko died tragically while participating in a motorcycle benefit run for the Combat Veterans. This scholarship will be dedicated to the memory of Officer Edward L. Witko #29.

Candidates must be enrolled in a college major in or related to the field of Criminal Justice. Students will be nominated by faculty and staff members who feel that the candidate will return something back to the community through a career in Law Enforcement field. The students must submit an essay of at least 250 words describing their future ambitions within the criminal justice field.

The application and essay must be submitted by Monday May 2, 2022. One finalist will then be chosen by the East Greenbush Police Benevolent Association.
