Arrests for Immediate Release October 2023

A 32 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Bernadette Ellis following a traffic stop. The defendant did operate a vehicle with a suspended NYS Non-Driver ID. The defendant was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the Third Degree and Unlicensed Operator. The defendant was field processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 22 year old Hamburg resident was arrested by Officer Matthew LaFortune following a traffic stop. The defendant did operate a vehicle with a suspended NYS Driver's License. The defendant was charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the Second Degree, No/Inadequate Headlamps and Unlicensed Operator. The defendant was field processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 36 year old Watervliet resident was arrested by Detective Sergeant Michael Guadagnino following a traffic stop. The defendant did operate a vehicle with a revoked NYS driver's license and did lie to officers about his name. The defendant was charged with AUO 2nd, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree, False Personation, Unlicensed Operator and Following Too Closely. The defendant was processed and arraigned in EGTC and remanded to Rensselaer County Jail, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 38 year old Rensselaer resident was arrested by Officer Peter Lavin following a traffic stop. The defendant did operate a vehicle with a suspended NYS driver's license and did possess stolen license plates. The defendant was charged with AUO 3rd, Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fifth Degree, Suspended Registration and Operating a Motor Vehicle with No Insurance. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 26 year old Troy resident was arrested by Sergeant Trevor LaGrave following a domestic incident. The defendant did strike the victim and then was combative with officers when he was being placed under arrest. The defendant was charged with Harassment in the Second Degree and Obstructing Governmental Administration in the Second Degree. The defendant was processed and deemed not mentally competent to be arraigned prior to mental health evaluation. The defendant was transported to Samaritan Hospital for mental evaluation.

An 18 year old Albany resident was arrested by Sergeant Trevor LaGrave following a harassment investigation. The defendant did threaten to kill the victim via text message. The defendant was charged with Aggravated Harassment in the Second Degree and Harassment in the Second Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and released on his own recognizance, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 26 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Nicholas Liuzzi following a domestic incident. The defendant did strike the victim and take the victim's phone when she attempted to call 911. The defendant was charged with Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree, Unlawful Imprisonment in the Second Degree, Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Criminal Obstruction of Breathing and Harassment in the Second Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and released on his own recognizance, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 66 year old Cohoes resident was arrested by Sergeant Ernest Tubbs following a traffic stop. The defendant did fail to stay in his lane while driving and did operate a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. The defendant was charged with DWI, Aggravated DWI, Open Container and Failure to Maintain Lane. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 37 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Anthony Belardo following a domestic incident. The defendant did lie to officers regarding her name. The defendant was charged with False Personation. The defendant was processed and released to Bruen Rescue Squad on an appearance ticket.

A 21 year old Watervliet resident was arrested by Officer Peter Lavin following an assault investigation. The defendant did strike the victim in the face multiple times causing pain and swelling. The defendant was charged with Assault in the Third Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and released on his own recognizance, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 33 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Detective Sergeant Michael Guadagnino following a domestic incident. The defendant did spit on the victim and break a door in the victim's home. The defendant was charged with Harassment in the Second Degree and Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 57 year old Glenmont resident was arrested by Officer Matthew LaFortune following a shoplifting complaint at Target. The defendant did pass all points of sale without paying for merchandise. The defendant was charged with Petit Larceny. The defendant was processed and released, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 25 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Officer Nicholas Liuzzi following a criminal mischief investigation. The defendant did destroy property not belonging to him. The defendant was charged with Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and released on his own recognizance, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 44 year old Albany resident was arrested by Officer Joseph Gumbrewicz following a shoplifting complaint at Walmart. The defendant did pass all points of sale without paying for merchandise. The defendant was charged with Petit Larceny. The defendant was processed and released, set to appear in court at a later date.

A 31 year old Mechanicville resident was arrested by Officer Edward Ashley following a domestic incident. The defendant did cut the victim's arm with a kitchen knife. The defendant was charged with Assault in the Second Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree. The defendant was processed, arraigned and remanded to Rensselaer County Jail, set to reappear in court at a later date.

A 58 year old Albany resident was arrested by Detective Sergeant Michael Guadagnino following a burglary investigation. The defendant did enter the victim's home with the intent to steal property. The defendant was charged with Burglary in the First Degree, Grand Larceny in the Second Degree, Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, Criminal Mischief in the Fourth Degree and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. The defendant was transported to Albany Medical Center after an incident in the City of Schenectady. The defendant was arraigned bedside in Albany Medical Center by a County Court Judge and was remanded to Rensselaer County Jail on no bail and turned over to the custody of the Rensselaer County Sheriff's Office.

A 57 year old East Greenbush resident was arrested by Sergeant Ernest Tubbs following a traffic stop. The defendant did operate a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The defendant was charged with DWI, Aggravated DWI, Reckless Driving, Failure to Use Designated Lane, Uninspected Motor Vehicle and Unregistered Motor Vehicle. The defendant was processed and released on an appearance ticket, set to appear in court at a later date.
